



Pan-African Youth Leadership Program **Student Application**

Program Description: The Pan-African Youth Leadership Program with (PAYLP) is a three-week exchange program in the United States for high school students and adult mentors. The primary program themes are civic education, community service, and youth leadership development. Participants live with host families for the majority of the exchange and engage in leadership and civic education workshops, community service activities, visits to local schools and community organizations, project planning and development, and local cultural activities with American peers. Participants return home with action plans to bring their exchange experience to their home communities in the form of a wide range of community service projects.

Student applicants must:

- ✓ Be a citizen and live in Malawi (applicants with dual U.S. citizenship will not be considered)
- ✓ Be between 15 - 18 years old by April 4, 2020;
- ✓ Have proficiency in English;
- ✓ Demonstrate good academic performance, leadership potential, an interest in and commitment to community service and volunteer activities;
- ✓ Demonstrate initiative, good communication, and an energetic, positive attitude;
- ✓ Have the ability to work cooperatively in a team and tolerate the opinions of others;
- ✓ Have permission from a parent or legal guardian to participate in the program.

There is no application fee. The United States Government will pay for all costs to participate in the program, including international travel to and from the United States, orientations, visa fees, and the exchange activities in the United States, including meals and lodging.
